

It all ends at the Fairhaven Festival - the best street fair of the year in Bellingham.

But so many people try to park near the events that parking is a mess down near the Festival. It is a hassle to find a bit of empty street curb to park next to - and then there is the long walk down hill to the Fest - and the longer walk up hill back to your car.

The Park & Ride really does work. We have been running it for 8 years now and it gets a little better each year. Often buses run only 10 minutes apart - and the ride is only 5 minutes to within a block of the Fest.

You park in Western Washington University lot C - the big lots on the south campus. Up to 3 buses during peak mid afternoon times run continuously between Fairhaven and the parking lot. \$1 each way - and passes are valid.

Last bus leaves Fairhaven at 8 pm - giving you plenty of time to enjoy the festival all afternoon.

We even provide a Porta Pottie at each bus stop.

*Avoid the parking problems near the festival -- take the quick, convenient bus.*

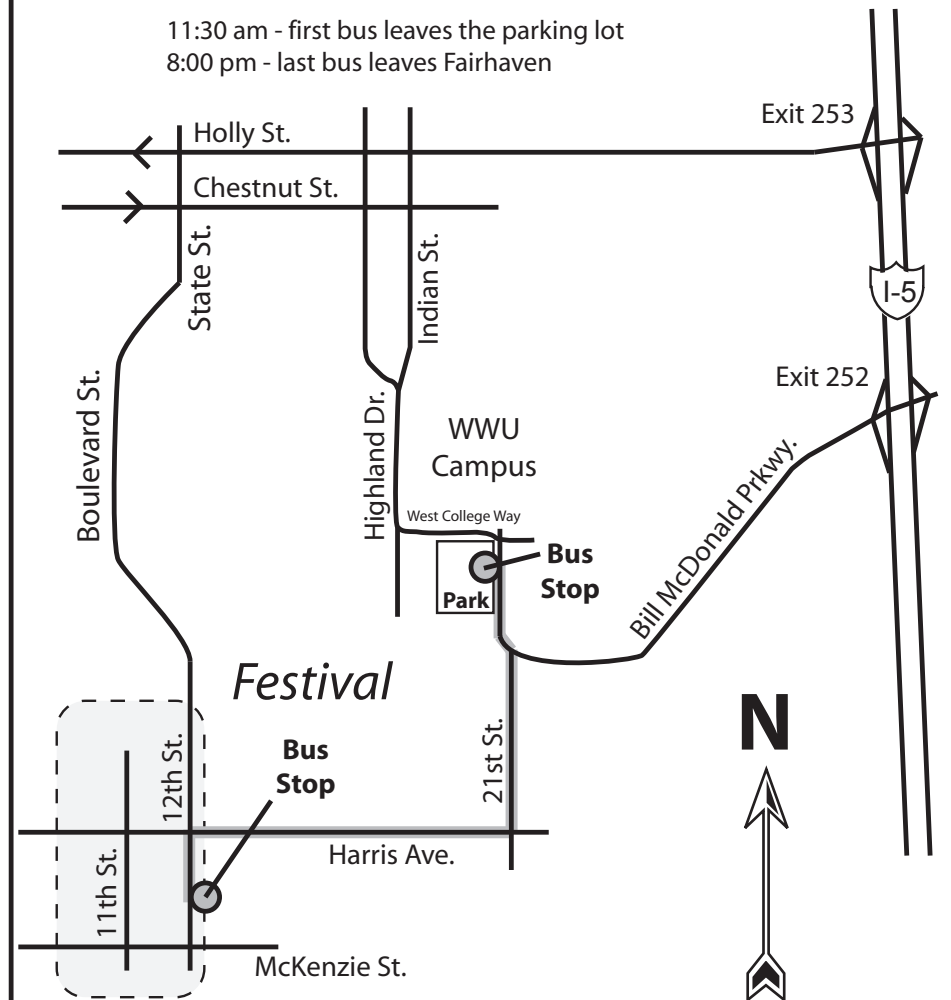
## Park & Ride Fairhaven Festival
